- **Academic Achievers (English or Mandarin)** (2yrs 8mths - 6yrs)  
**Dates:** 27/02, 13/03, 20/03, 27/03

An opportunity for a more in-depth regular input into your child's English or Mandarin speaking ability. Conducted by experienced teachers, the weekly sessions follow a theme so that children's learning is supported at the same time as promoting confident English or Mandarin speakers with a wide vocabulary. Academic Achievers is a treasure trove of interesting opportunities - rhymes, songs, stories, reading & writing games, arts & crafts, music & drama, action games, computer games, cooking and "Tang" poetry recital in Mandarin. Mixed ages work well together and benefit from one another in these generously staffed classes where the maximum class size is 15.

- **Playgroup** (1yr 6mths - 2yrs 8mths)  
**Dates:** 27/02, 13/03, 20/03, 27/03

In our Playgroup, students will experience energetic play based learning through stimulating activities that are linked to the English Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum. We are preparing today's children to use the English language in all our activities and to become independent thinkers and learners of the future. Mums and Dads will also have the opportunity to meet other parents and build a supportive network of friends.

- **Toddlerobics** (1yr - 2yrs)  
**Dates:** 27/02, 13/03, 20/03, 27/03

It's an exciting, energetic, musical exercise programme, created to develop your child's physical, musical and language skills. Through rhymes and songs your child will develop their English language, while improving their listening skills and hand-eye coordination through energetic musical activities. Children will work individually, in groups and as a whole class. This allows them to develop their independence in a comfortable and friendly environment.

These courses are a great opportunity for your child to begin to socialise with others and develop their language skills in a safe and engaging environment.
